



Dear Caregiver,

Thank you for your interest in Project Lifesaver WNY. Run in conjunction with the Erie County Sheriff's Office, Project Lifesaver WNY is a proven program designed to help vulnerable individuals who may wander. Used by more than 1,000 law enforcement agencies nationwide, Project Lifesaver has a 100% success rate and is responsible for more than 2,000 rescues of children and adults alike.

There are three simple steps to get started with Project Lifesaver WNY:

1. Complete and return the attached/enclosed "Intake" form. This is the exact information that will be kept with the Erie County Sheriff's Office dispatch. (Please be as accurate and detailed as possible.)
2. Complete and return the attached/enclosed "Project Lifesaver WNY Legal Agreement".
3. Enclose a \$420 first year payment (cash, check or money order made payable to Project Lifesaver WNY). The \$420 cost breaks down as follows:
  - a. \$300 is the one time cost of the unique radio frequency transmitter. This transmitter is worn by the client (similar to a hospital bracelet or concert wristband), it is completely waterproof and emits an inaudible "chirp" every second, 24 hours per day – for 30 days. This transmitter can be tracked by the Erie County Sheriff's Office (or any other of the more than 2,000 participating agencies nationwide).
  - b. \$120 is the cost of 12 months worth of batteries, straps and snaps for your transmitter.

After year one, the cost to continue in the program is only the cost of the batteries, straps and snaps (estimated to remain at \$120).
